Each entry will be judged on originality, adherence to ag based theme, design technique, and total impact. Winners will be announced on **May 8<sup>th</sup>**.

### Top 3 Entries

- Artwork and Profile of the Artist Published in WFB Neighbors Magazine
- Artwork Displayed at WFB Events

1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$200 and Classroom Ice Cream or Pizza Party (upon school approval)

2<sup>nd</sup> Prize \$100

3<sup>rd</sup> Prize \$75

**1<sup>st</sup> Place Entry will be auctioned at the Washington Farm Bureau Annual Meeting in November, these funds will support future art contests and other agricultural outreach activities.**

## Contest Rules & Directions:

1. Contestants must be U.S. Citizens enrolled in Middle School, Junior High, or High School in the state of Washington.
2. The file format of all entries must be a PDF submitted via photograph or scan of the original art. Original art can be any medium (**no photography or digital media permitted**). Please do not frame your original art. Original art should be no smaller than 8" x 10"

  - a. **Name, Full Address, School, Year in School, Email Address , Brief Description of Artwork including Medium used. Attach PDF of original artwork.**
4. Entry must be submitted by midnight on **April 30<sup>th</sup>**.
5. Only one entry submitted per student
6. 1<sup>st</sup> place entry becomes the property of the Washington Farm Bureau.
7. Washington Farm Bureau retains the printing rights for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place entries.
8. Entries must not violate any copyrights or trademarks
9. Failure to adhere to the rules may result in disqualification.
